SEPTEMBER 12, 2022

For 2022, the WPC planned to revive and highlight the true essence of democracy in contemporary Pakistan. With the theme of Inclusive Democracy: Priorities and Challenges in 2022, WPC presented its contributions to International Day of Democracy by discussing parliamentary endeavors and highlighting the developing democratic framework of Pakistan.

WPC team briefed the delegation on the role of Caucus in promoting women-specific issues and effectiveness of such cross-party alliances in Parliamentary democracies.

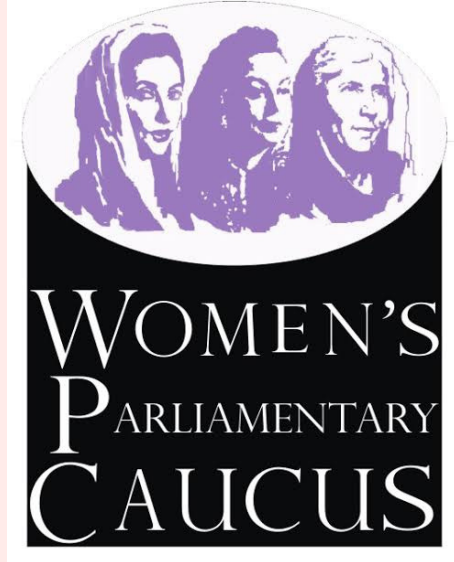


SECRETARY WPC MEETING WITH COUNTRY DIRECTOR PODA PAKISTAN
