# NATIONAL CONVENTION OF WOMEN PARLIAMENTARIANS


(FEBRUARY 13, 2023)



The Women's Parliamentary Caucus hosted the National Convention of Women Parliamentarians on February 13th, 2023 at Pakistan National Council of Arts (PNCA) in Islamabad. The theme of the convention was "Empowering Women in Leadership" and focused on the participation and inclusion of women in the political process. The event included Keynote Speaker Honorable Speaker National Assembly of Pakistan, Mr. Raja Pervaiz Ashraf, as well as a main panel discussion session titled "What is the Political Landscape of Pakistan with or without women?".



The event provided a unique opportunity for female parliamentarians to collaborate on ways to promote the empowerment of women in leadership positions and share their experiences, struggles, and insights with journalists and members of the media. WPC, under the leadership of Dr. Rehmani, is dedicated to promoting gender equality and the empowerment of women in all aspects of life. National Convention of Women Parliamentarians is one of the initiatives the Caucus has undertaken to support this goal.



## WPC UP IN ARMS OVER RISE IN RAPE CASES




WPC strongly condemned the incident of rape of bus hostess in moving bus proceeding to Vehari and F-9 Park Islamabad and called for robust action against perpetrators.

Dr. Rehmani also strongly registered her protest on the Floor of the House regarding such incidences and that the country is becoming increasingly unsafe for women. She pointed out towards extremist mindsets which perpetrate rape and its apologists. She even raised the matter in the Human Rights Committee.



Secretary WPC, Dr. Shahida Rehmani later wrote a letter to Inspector General (IG) Islamabad and expressed her concern about the state of security for women. She directed the IG to provide a detailed investigation report of the incident.



## WPC AND PODA TO FIND AVENUES TO EMPOWER RURAL WOMENT

Representatives of Potohar Organization for Development Advocacy (PODA) visited Women's Parliamentary Caucus (WPC) Secretariat. # WPC AND FAFEN TO ENHANCE POLITICAL PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN


(FEBRUARY 26, 2023)


